Understanding Your Electrical Reconnect Permit

Before the power can be turned on, an inspection of the exterior of the building must be performed. Upon completion of the approved inspection, Texas New Mexico Power will be notified by the City of Sweeny. Your provider will need to contact Texas New Mexico Power.

If your inspection is not approved, the appropriate corrections will need to be made. Permits must be pulled by your licensed electrician prior to work being commenced. A re-inspection must be scheduled after service is brought up to code.

A reconnect permit is required each time there is a name change on the service statement, disconnection of service, or change in electrical providers.

The City of Sweeny general liability for Building, Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical contractors is \$300,000. Should the insurance be terminated or expire, no inspections will be performed until valid insurance is received. This is a requirement for any permit that requires general liability insurance. Under no circumstances will paid fees be refunded or transferred. Applications and plans will be held for 180 days. After 180 days this application and plans will be voided and disposed of unless a valid building permit is issued. The City of Sweeny has adopted the International Building Code, National Electrical Code, Standard Plumbing, Mechanical and Gas Codes, NFPA, and International Fire Code. All building construction plans should adhere to these building codes. APPROVED PERMIT BECOMES VOID IF WORK OR CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZED IS NOT COMMENCED WITHIN 180 DAYS. FEES WILL DOUBLE IF WORK IS COMMENCED BEFORE VAILD PERMIT IS ACQUIRED.
